

ACC PROCESS OF APPEALS

For any homeowner who has had a request denied by the ACC Committee, the homeowner may submit an appeal to the Board of Directors in writing within 30 days of the date of the denial as dated and recorded by the ACC, delivered personally to any current board member or sent through the U.S. mail via certified letter to the home address of the acting board President. After receiving the request for appeal from the homeowner the Board, within 10 working days may, at its discretion, let stand and uphold the decision of the ACC, or reverse and/or overrule the decision in favor of the homeowner by a majority vote of the Board members.
